Uncle Roy undertook his elementary flying training at Wagga Wagga NSW Australia and graduated as Sergeant Pilot after completing SFTS under the EATS at Calgary Canada on Cessna Cranes. He joined 150 Squadron RAF in Bomber Command where he was second pilot flying Wellingtons in a crew of 3 RAF and 3 RAAF members. The entire crew was lost when their aircraft crashed near Scampton on 30 May 1942 following a 1000 bomber raid on Cologne.
